SUBJECT DEFINITIONS

The Club reserves the right to reject any image which may be deemed offensive.

February – OPEN

Any subject matter may be entered.

March – FLORA OR FAUNA

An image of any flower, plant, tree, fungus, animal, bird, fish, reptile, insect, spider, or crustacean. Photographs of mounted specimens, domestic pets and obviously set arrangements are ineligible. Photographic manipulations which alter the truth are not acceptable.

April – A PHONE PHOTO

A photo taken on a mobile phone or tablet but NOT on a camera.

The meta data must support that the image was created on a mobile phone/tablet. The topic is OPEN and any subject can be entered.

May - SCAPES

Scapes includes Landscapes, Seascapes, Waterscapes, Skyscapes and/or Cityscapes. Any scenic view where the main subject matter is the view captured and depicted. People may be included in the scene as long as they are ancillary to the main subject.

June – OPEN

Any subject matter may be entered.

July - SHADOWS

Shadow photography is defined as any photo that uses shadows as a prominent part of the composition to enhance the contrast of a subject or as the subject itself. Any subject that complies with the OPEN definition may be entered.

August – PHOTOJOURNALISM and/or SOCIAL DOCUMENTARY Story-telling photographs such as are seen in the news media and periodicals, which may include documentary, contemporary life, illustrative, spot news, sporting events or human interest stories. Alternatively, the photograph may be concerned with the portrayal and interpretation of society encompassing both human and non-human subject matter.

In the interest of credibility, contrived situations or photographic manipulations which alter the truth are not acceptable. The story telling value of the photograph shall be weighed more than the pictorial quality.

September - PORTRAIT

A photograph of a person or persons that may range from a head study to full body length. This definition includes candid photographs and formal portraits.

October - YELLOW

YELLOW for Colour prints and DPI, OPEN for Monochrome Prints.

• Colour Prints and DPI - An image which features the colour

Yellow.

• Monochrome Prints - Any subject matter that complies with the

OPEN definition may be entered.

November – END OF YEAR Entries of the best prints/digital projected images of the year. All entries must be presented exactly as originally submitted. No remounting, further manipulation or adjustments or changes to the titles is allowed.
